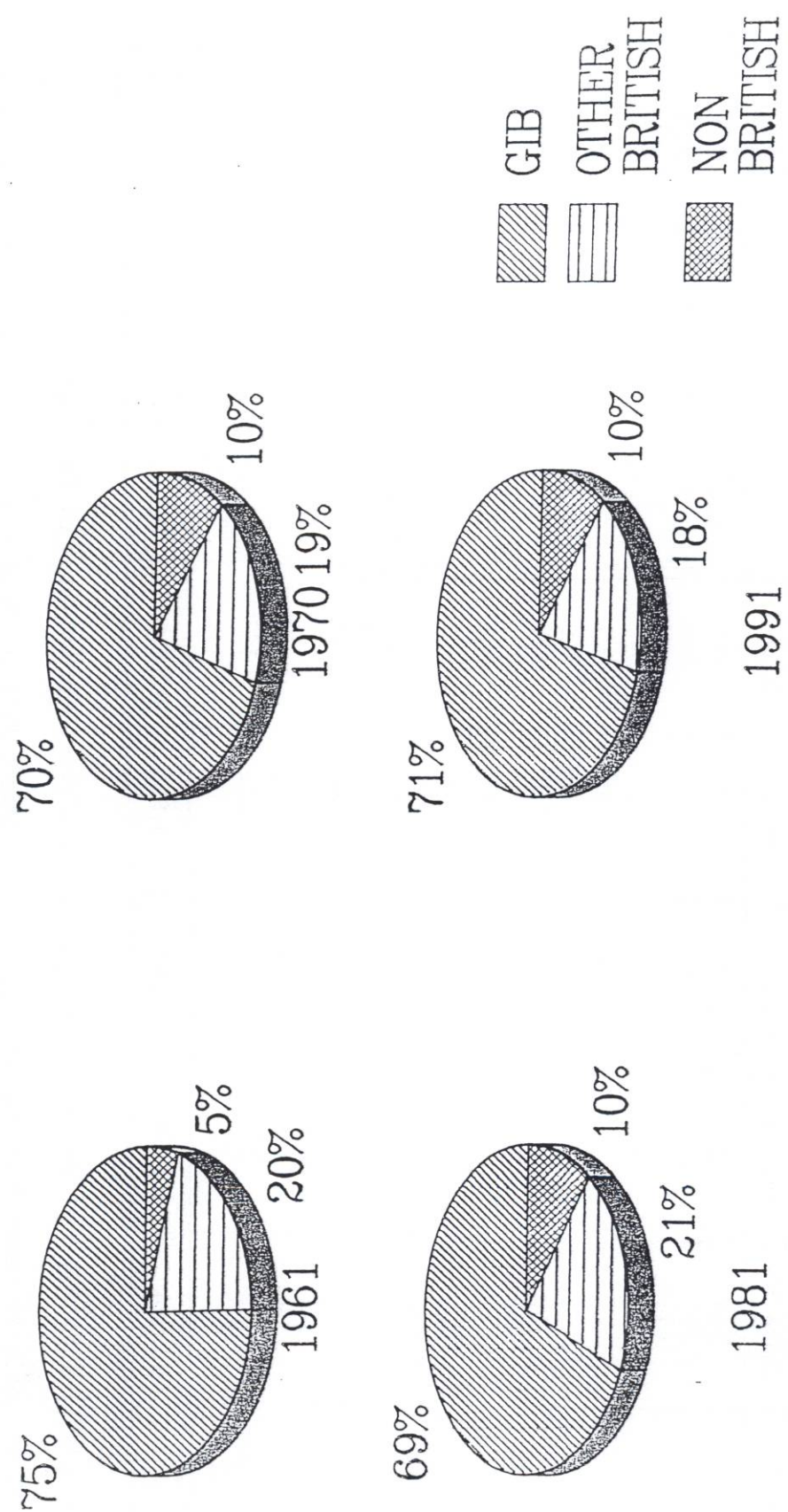

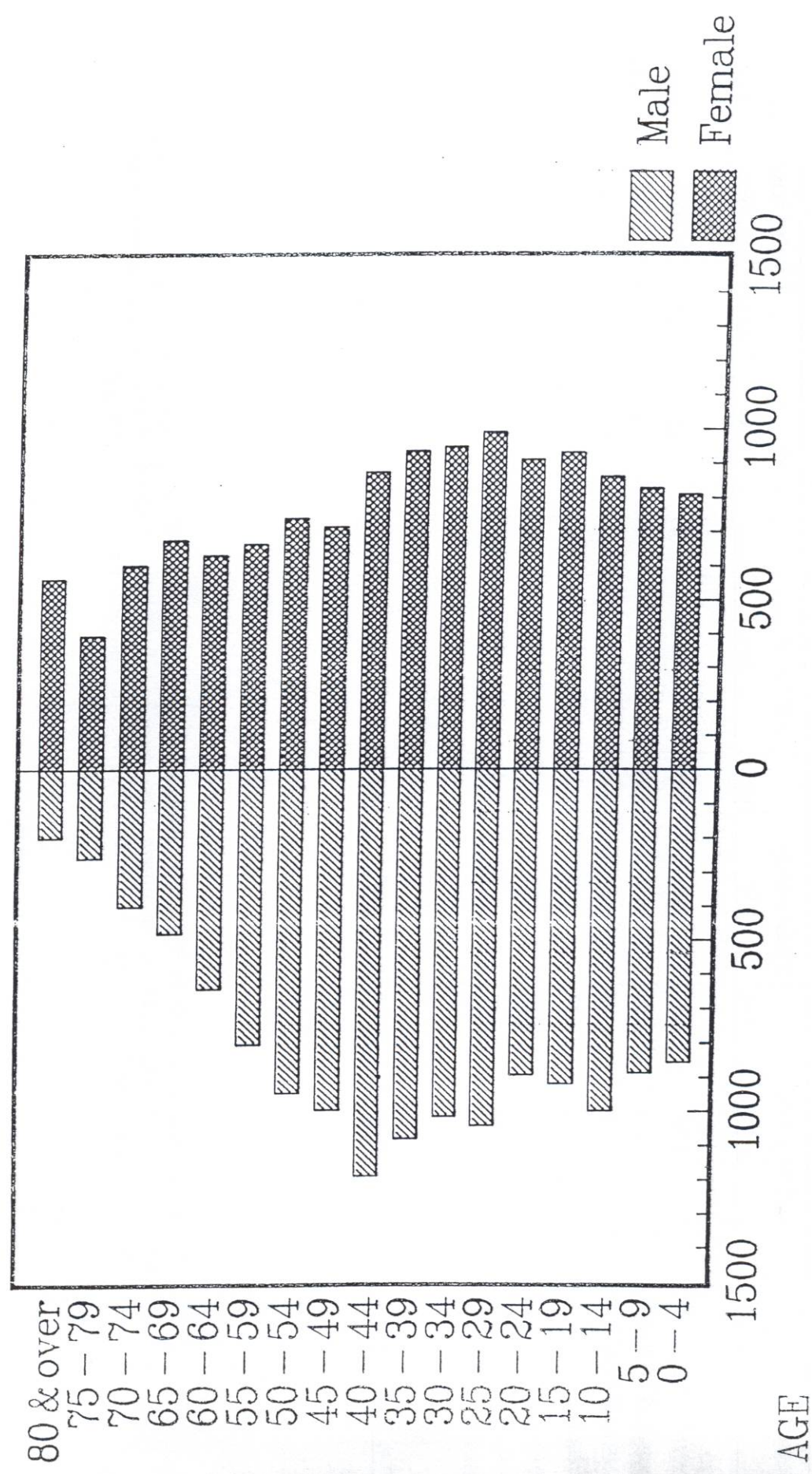

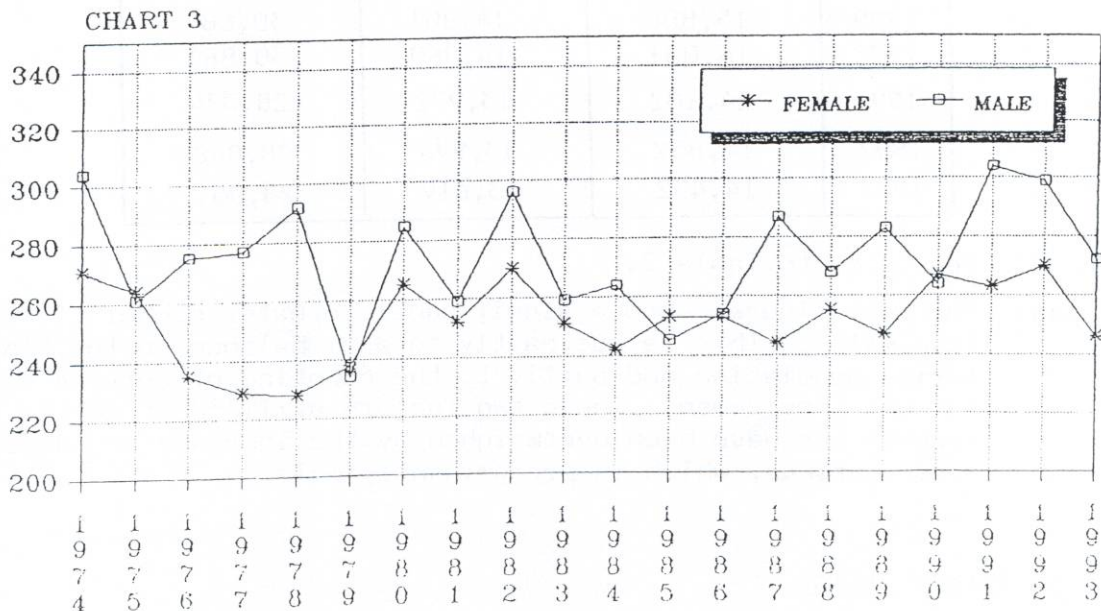

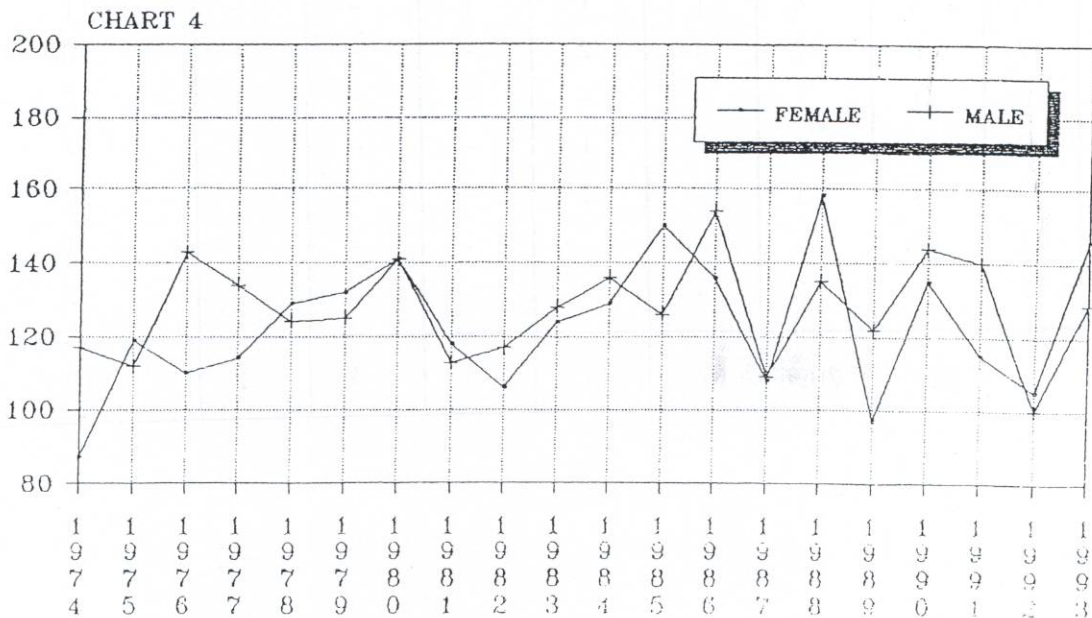

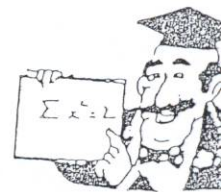

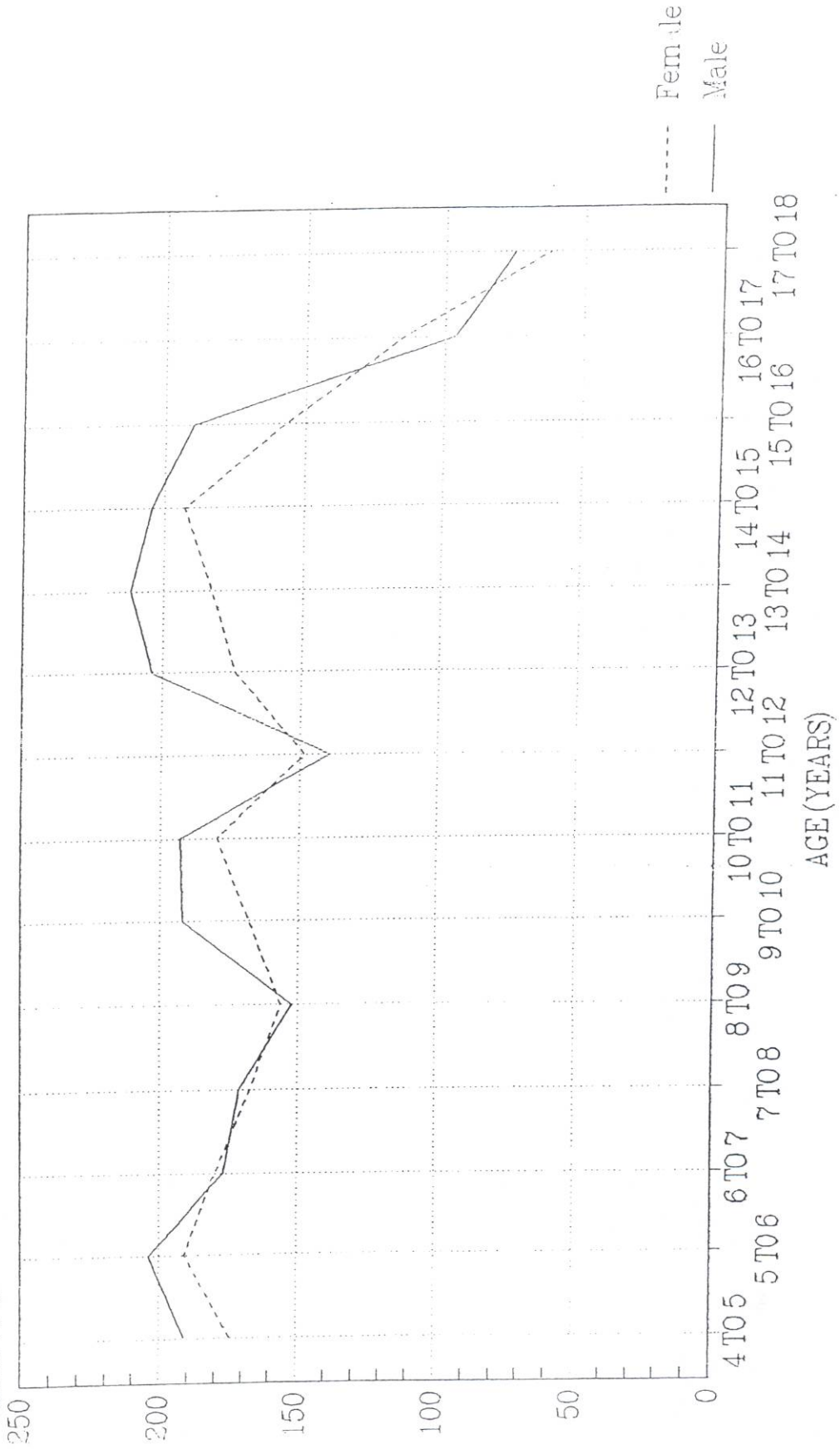

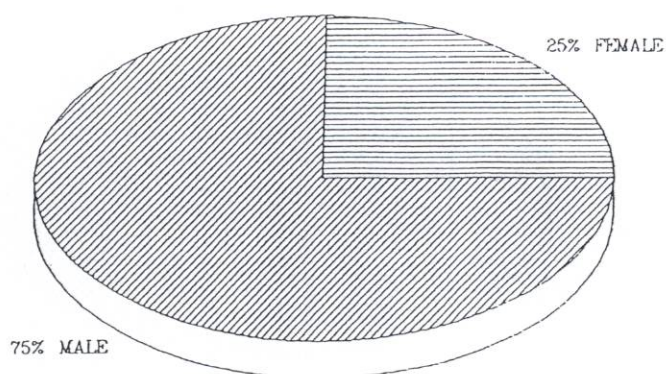

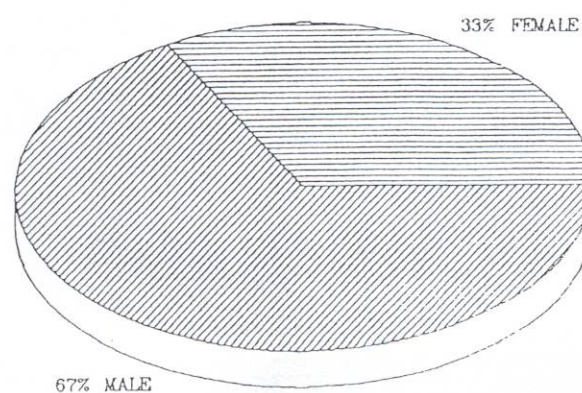

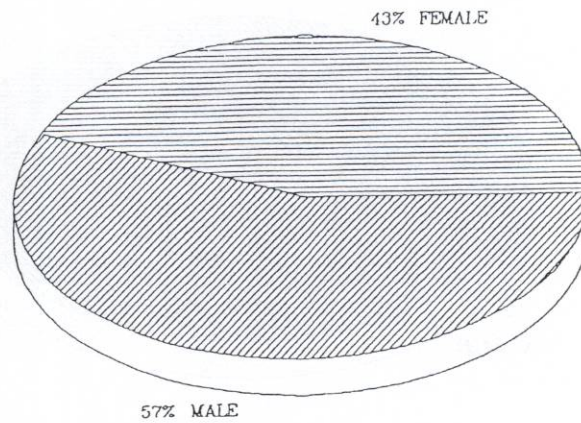

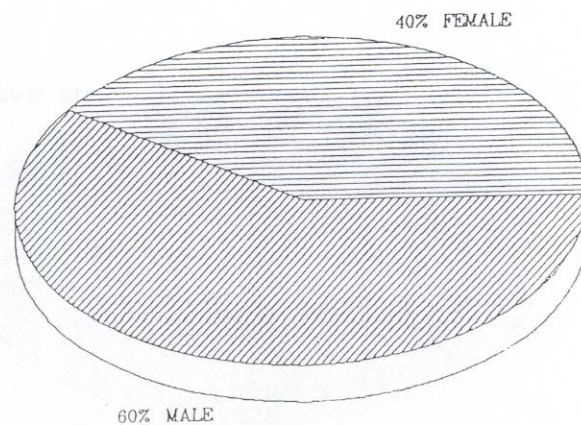

GIBRALTAR I.R.P. (ALL ITEMS) (JAN 1966-JAN 1993)

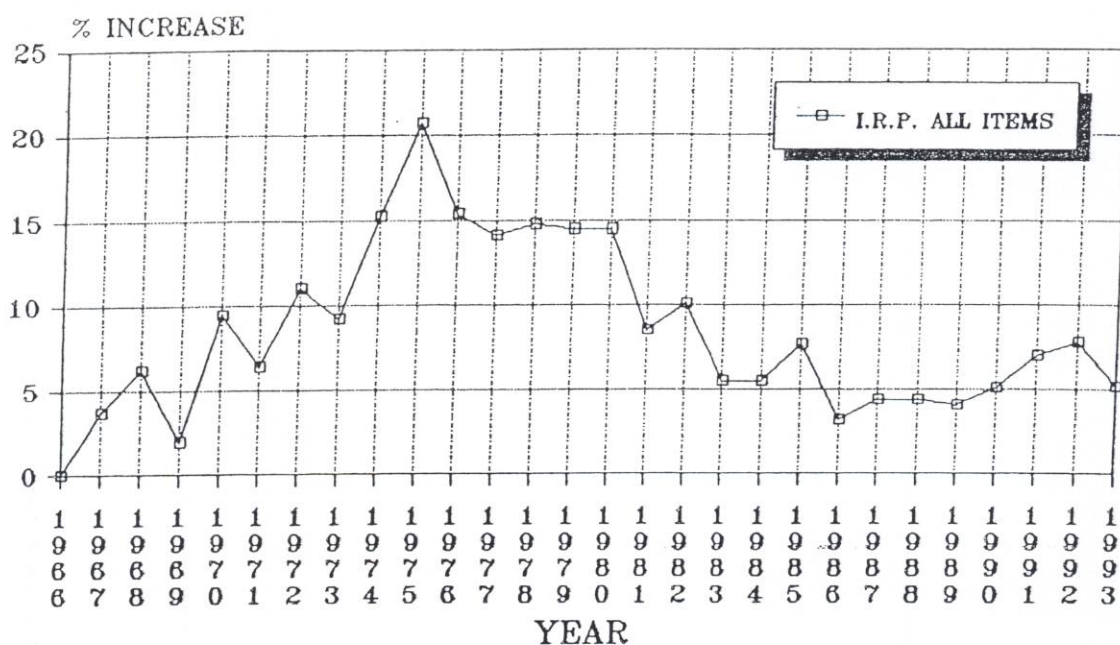

Gibraltar I.R.P. (FOOD GROUP) (JAN 1975-JAN 1993)

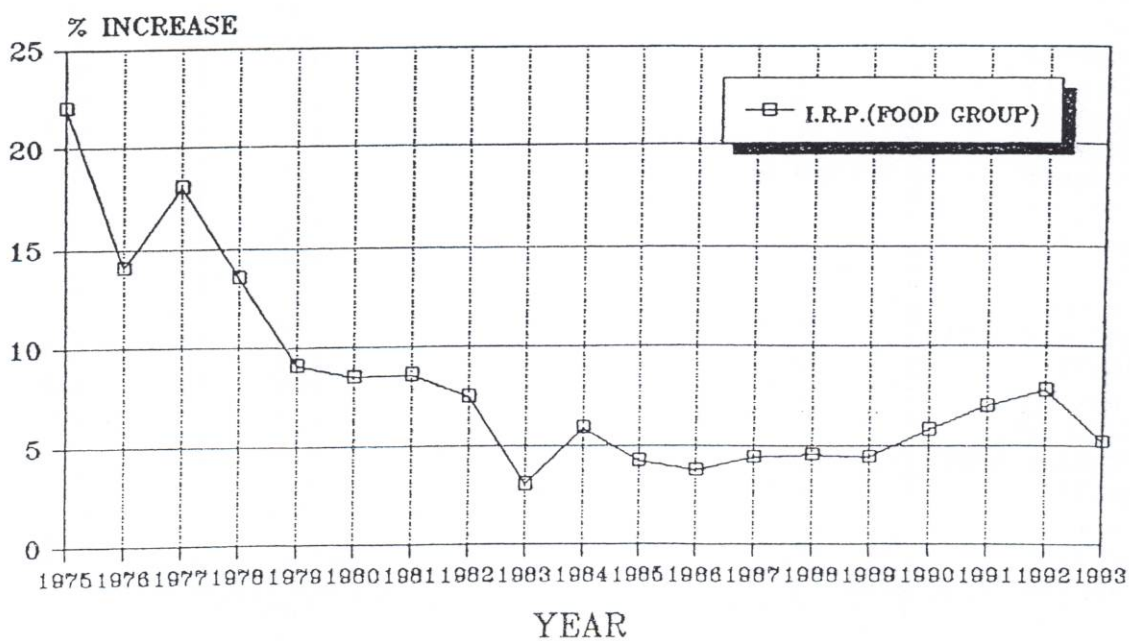

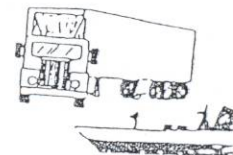

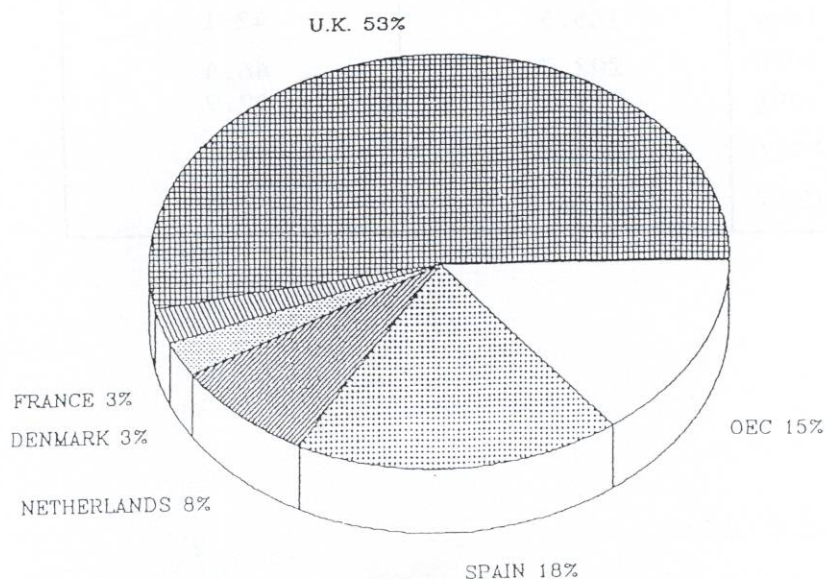

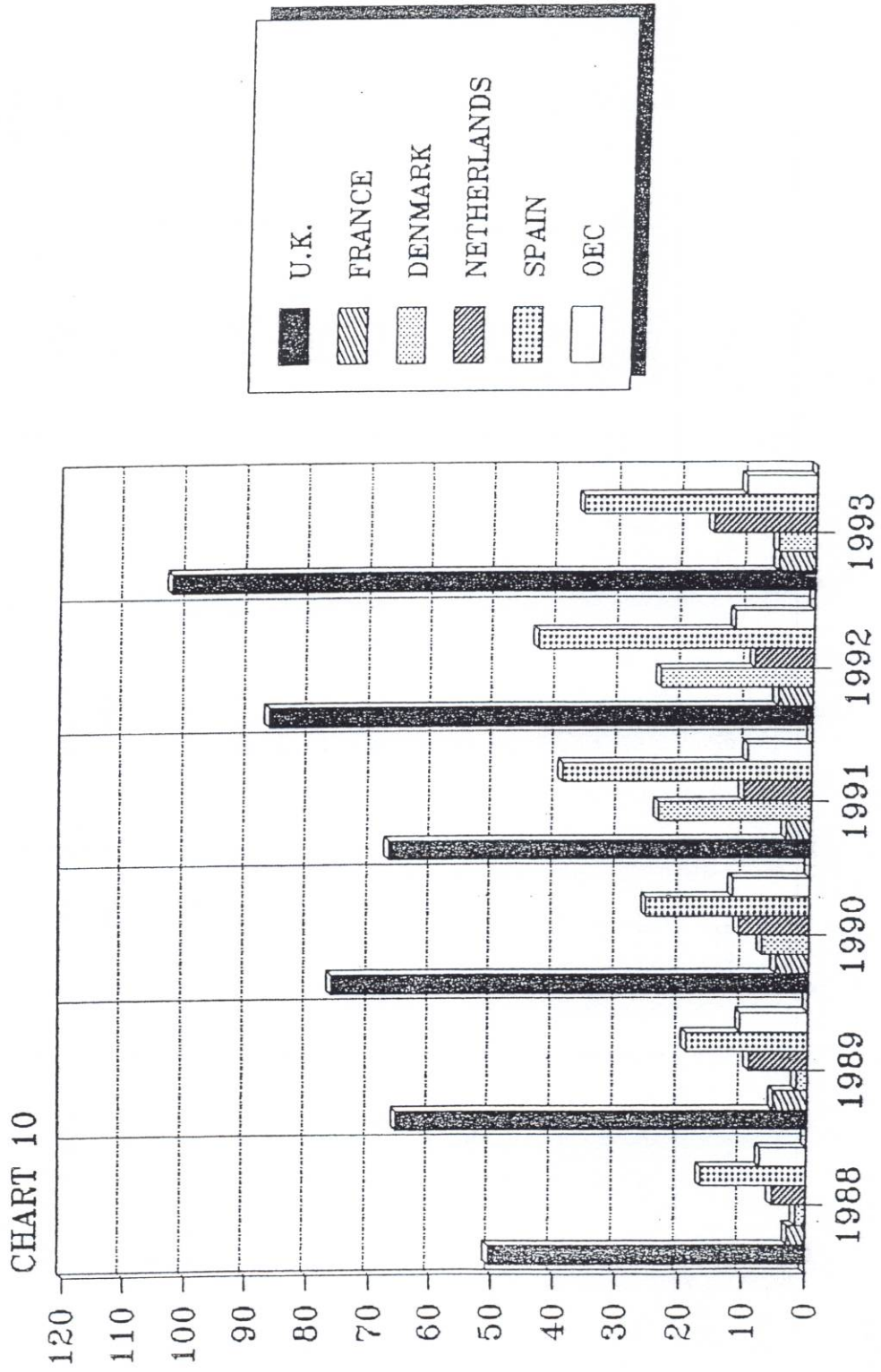

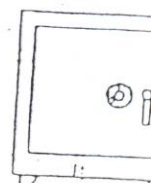

NEW REGISTRATIONS 1976-1993

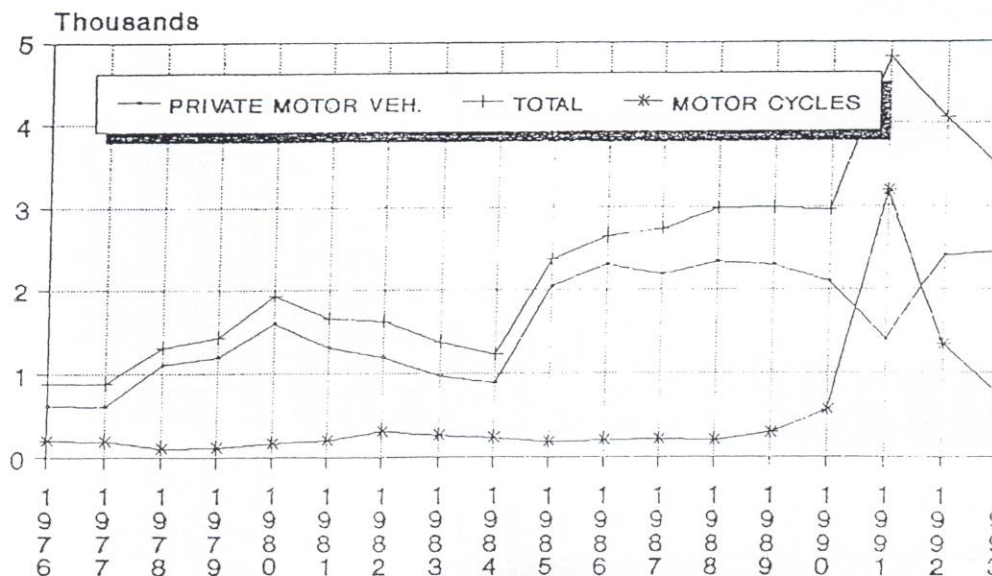


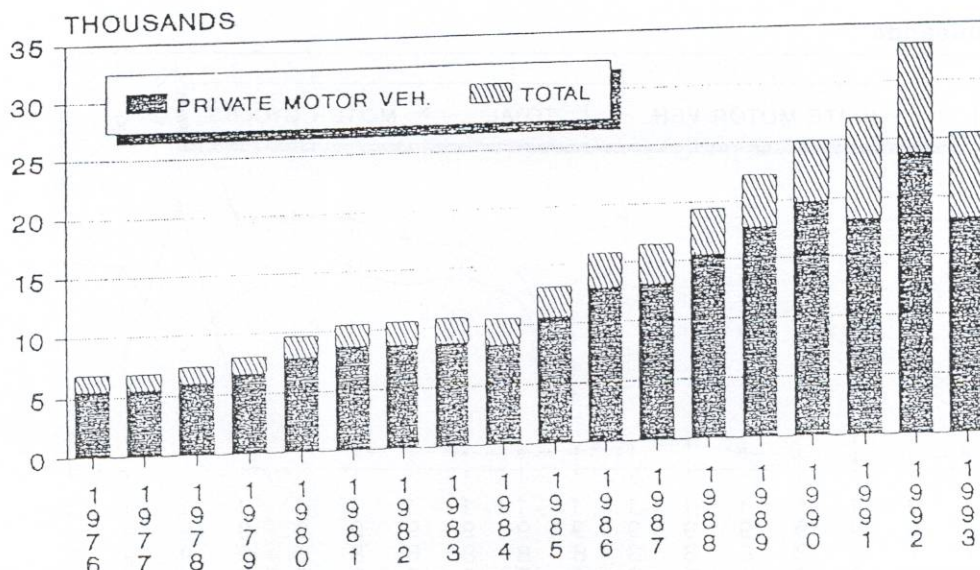

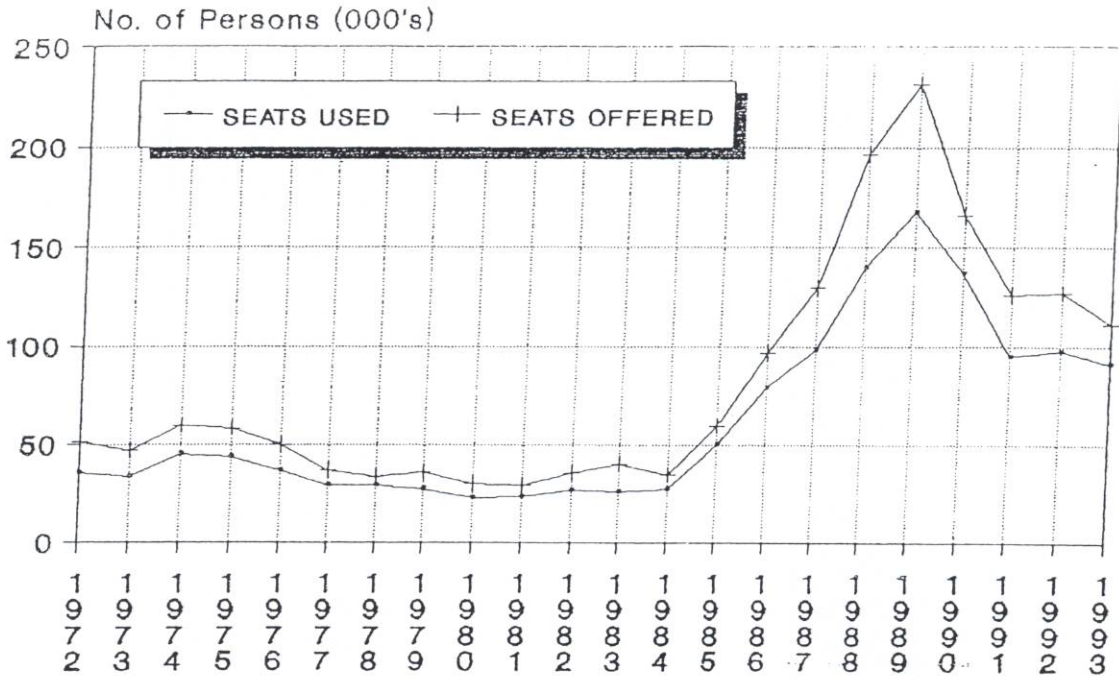

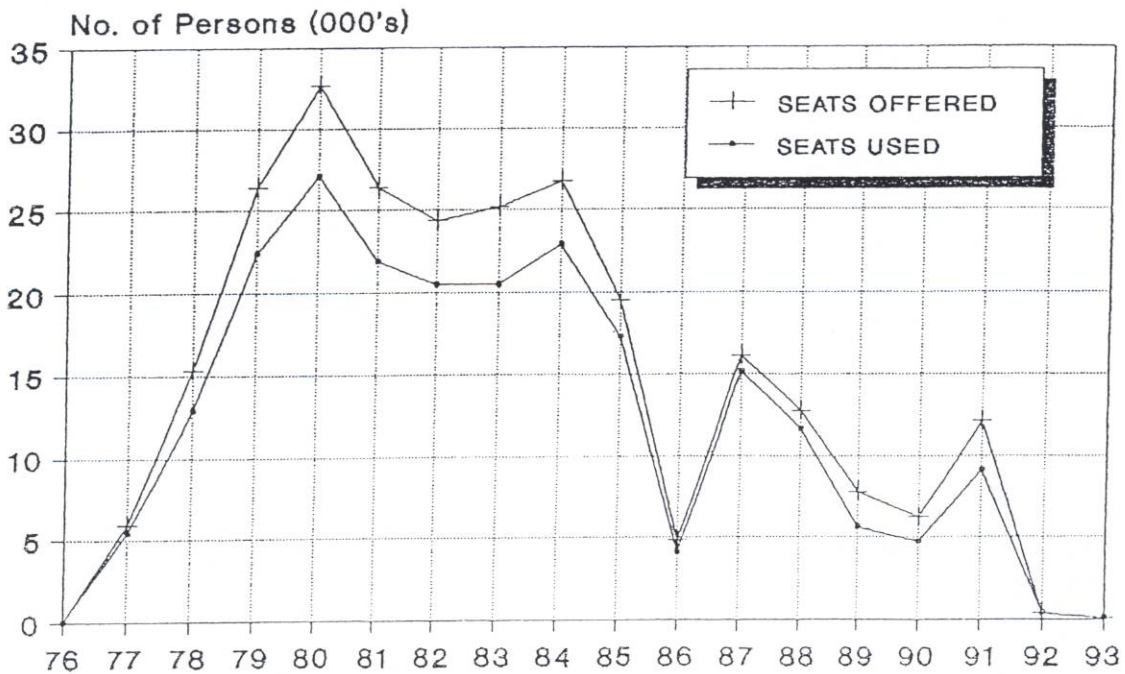

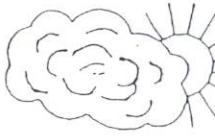
